Derman became one of the first Turkish/Kurdish charity organisations in the whole of UK to have a **BACP** accredited counselling service.

Derman provides a range of health-related services freely, at no cost, to Kurdish, Turkish, Turkish Cypriot and Eastern European Turkish people mainly refugees and asylum seekers mainly in Hackney. Derman's services are all completely non-denominational and politically unaligned.

The services include **Bi-Lingual Health Advocacy, Counselling, Mental Health Recovery Support, Welfare Rights Advice and Community Support Navigation for individuals and families.**
